Success Maker

This is a computer program to assist students in math, reading, and keyboarding. These courses can be used to enrich, maintain, or reinforce what the children know or should know.

We have been successful in helping students with our “Success Maker” Computer Program. The program has been expanded to include enrichment students.

Detailed records are kept by the computer on a student’s time-on-task, percent correct, and level of instruction. These will be available for teachers, students, and parents.

To sign your child up for working on the computer, you can download a form for the school website. You just have to go to the special needs under classrooms. Return the form to the office or Mrs. Gerndt. If you do not have the internet, please ask for a form from the office.
